演題：The Health Gap: the Challenge of an Unequal World

紹介： Prof. Sir Michael Marmot has been acknowledged as the leading scholar and advocate on the social determinants of health to close the health gap across socio-economic conditions in the society. For over 35 years, Sir Michael has lead the Whitehall Study II, a well-known benchmarking cohort study in the field of social epidemiology that empirically proved social class impact on health. He also served as the chairperson for the WHO's Commission on Social Determinants of Health (2005-2008), of which activities were summarized in "Closing the Gap in a Generation" as a guiding report for health policy making to combat health inequality. Most recently he serves as President of the World Medical Association to extend his advocacy to the world-wide alliance to achieve "health for all." In this special lecture, Sir Michael presents his recent book titled "The Health Gap: the Challenge of an Unequal World" and will bring a message to young health science scholars that health inequality is not a matter of unequal access to healthcare and health-related skills/knowledge, but more; Creating the conditions for people to lead flourishing lives through empowerment is the key to reduce health gap.
