

**Foreign Language (English) Requirement for the Entrance Examination
for the Professional Degree Program, the School of Public Health**

※Application Guide will be released in May 2026.

Foreign language (English) written examination is not administered by the University of Tokyo to applicants for the Professional Degree Program, the School of Public Health, Graduate School of Medicine, the University of Tokyo. In lieu of those examinations, applicants are required to submit an official report of their TOEFL scores as below. Unless all the three steps below (1–3) are completed, we cannot accept your test results.

1. Type of test

TOEFL-iBT, TOEFL iBT Home Edition

2. Period of Validity

Earned after 1 August 2024

3. Method of score submission

① Send the TOEFL Official Score Report.

Between the time you register for the TOEFL and the day before the test, log into your ETS account and request that your Official Score Report be sent to our school. When doing so, please enter the code below. This also applies if you wish to use a previously taken TOEFL-iBT score (within its validity period).

- If the submission process is completed correctly and there are no issues with the test itself, our graduate school can view the official scores online approximately 8 days after the test date. However, please take the test well in advance, as technical issues during the test or delays in score release may require you to retake the exam.
- You may complete the score submission procedure before applying for graduate school admission. If you have previously arranged to send a valid score to the above “TOEFL Official Score Report Recipient,” you do not need to resubmit it.

- You may submit your score report multiple times. Only the score report corresponding to the Appointment Number and test date registered in step ② below will be accepted.

- We are unable to respond to individual inquiries regarding the arrival status of score reports.

② Register the Appointment Number and test date in the “WEB Application System”.

Register the Appointment Number and test date for the score report you will submit in the “WEB Application System” by the designated score submission deadline.

③ Upload the Test Taker Score Report to the “WEB Application System”.

Please upload the Test Taker Score Report (PDF) for the Appointment Number and test date registered in step ② to the “WEB Application System” by the designated score submission deadline. The Test Taker Score Report (PDF) can be downloaded from your ETS account approximately 8 days after the test date.
