## Online examinations of the School of Medical Science, Master's Program

The written examination (Subject Test I) and oral examination will be conducted online. A connection test for the online exams will be held early or middle August 2021. Details of the URL for accessing the online examinations, answer sheets, and others will be sent to each applicant by e-mail after application.

### 1. Preparations for the online exams

- (1) Prepare a bright and quiet private room where the test is to be taken, no one other than the examinee is allowed to enter, and entrances and exits, windows, and curtains can be closed. Examinations in public spaces such as parks, internet cafes and restaurants are not permitted.
- (2) Entrance examination admission ticket
- (3) Writing instruments (black pencil or mechanical pencil, eraser, and pencil sharpener), and clock (only for timekeeping function)
- (4) Designated A4 (or letter-size) answer sheets and calculation sheets
- (5) Strong and stable network environment
  - One computer (13-inch or larger display is recommended; multiple displays cannot be used)
  - Microphone (a built-in computer microphone is also acceptable)
  - Speaker(s) (can be built into the computer)
  - One external webcam (with a cable of ~2 m long. If it is not long enough, prepare an extension cable. The computer camera is unacceptable).
- (6) A smartphone with a phone number that can be used to contact you on the exam day, and that can take and send photos.

\* The connection test should be conducted in the same environment as on the August 16 exam day.

\* It is the responsibility of the applicant to prepare an appropriate room and network environment. Inadequate preparation may result in disqualification from the examination.

\*Headphones/earphones/headsets cannot be used.

### 2. Points to note for the online exams

- (1) Electronic devices/information devices other than the PC and camera that are used to connect to the online exams, dictionaries, textbooks, or other items that assist in answering the questions cannot be used during the exams. It is not allowed to record audio or video of the PC during the exams.
- (2) If we judge that there has been fraudulent activity such as spoofing or cheating by another person, you may be rejected. If we judge that there had been misconduct even after you passed, entered, or graduated, we may cancel your pass, enter, or graduate.
- (3) You cannot leave your PC after the online exam starts. You are not allowed to leave the room, even if you finish answering the questions or abandon your exam. Please be prepared not to leave the PC during the exam, for reason such as going to the bathroom.
