1. Additional documents to be submitted

1) Essay

- Use the provided format.
- Maximum length 700 words in English or 1,600 letters in Japanese. Up to one A4 pages.
- Theme:
Please briefly describe the issues and future vision of the research field you are applying for, based on your previous research and your own experience. In addition, please describe how you would like to contribute to this field of study and your own vision of the future.
- Both Print submission and Online submission are required.
- As for a printed version, send it along with other application documents by post. As for an electric file, either MS Word or other Text-based format is acceptable. Submit it as below. PDF file is NOT acceptable.

2) Declaration of authenticity

- Please sign and submit the provided format.
- ONLY print submission is required. Send it along with other application documents by post.

2. Online submission of “Research Plan”, “Master’s thesis” and “Essay”

Stated in 6. Application procedure (4) in the revised application guidelines dated November 24, please also send the electronic data of the Research Plan, Master's thesis and Essay as follows. ALL applicants need to submit a Research Plan, while limited applicants need to submit a Master's thesis and an Essay as above 1.

<Format of online submission>

1. Filenames should be formatted as follows.

(SHSN admission) 1 Research Plan (Name)

e.g.: (SHSN admission) 1 Research Plan (Hanako Igaku)

- Only PDF file is acceptable.

- Must be submitted by ALL applicants

(SHSN admission) 2 Master's thesis (Name)

e.g.: (SHSN admission) 2 Master's thesis (Hanako Igaku)

- Only PDF file is acceptable.

- Applicants who expect to complete a master's degree at the School of Health Sciences and Nursing in Graduate School of Medicine, UTokyo between 1 April, 2021 and 31 March 2022 are NOT required to submit.

(SHSN admission) 3 Essay (Name)

e.g.: (SHSN admission) 3 Essay (Hanako Igaku)

- Only MS Word or other Text-based format is acceptable. PDF file is NOT acceptable.

- Applicants who expect to complete a master's degree or a professional degree in Graduate School of Medicine, UTokyo between 1 April, 2021 and 31 March 2022 are NOT required to submit.

2. Convert and compress all the files with ZIP file format (No other compressor formats acceptable)

3. Zip file name should be titled as (SHSN admission) Name as follows, then upload it on

e.g.: (SHSN admission) Hanako Igaku

[NOTES] Administration staff will not respond to any inquiry on whether the electronic data has been uploaded or not.

Applicants who are expected to complete a master's program of School of Health Sciences and Nursing, the Graduate School of Medicine, UTokyo, in March 2022, only need to upload the Research Plan above as in 1. To <https://bit.ly/3mxOXQe>. The description about the zip file in 2 and 3 above can be ignored.
