【Financial and Housing Reliefs】

1. Students who have difficulties continuing to be enrolled at the University because of financial problems as a result of the earthquakes in Kumamoto and are from the areas designated for relief by the *Disaster Relief Act*, may request for the following financial aids: entrance fee exemption, tuition fees exemption, and scholarships from JASSO (Japanese Student Services Organization).
